

kriderii

ADULT



males average paler

some show extensively white head

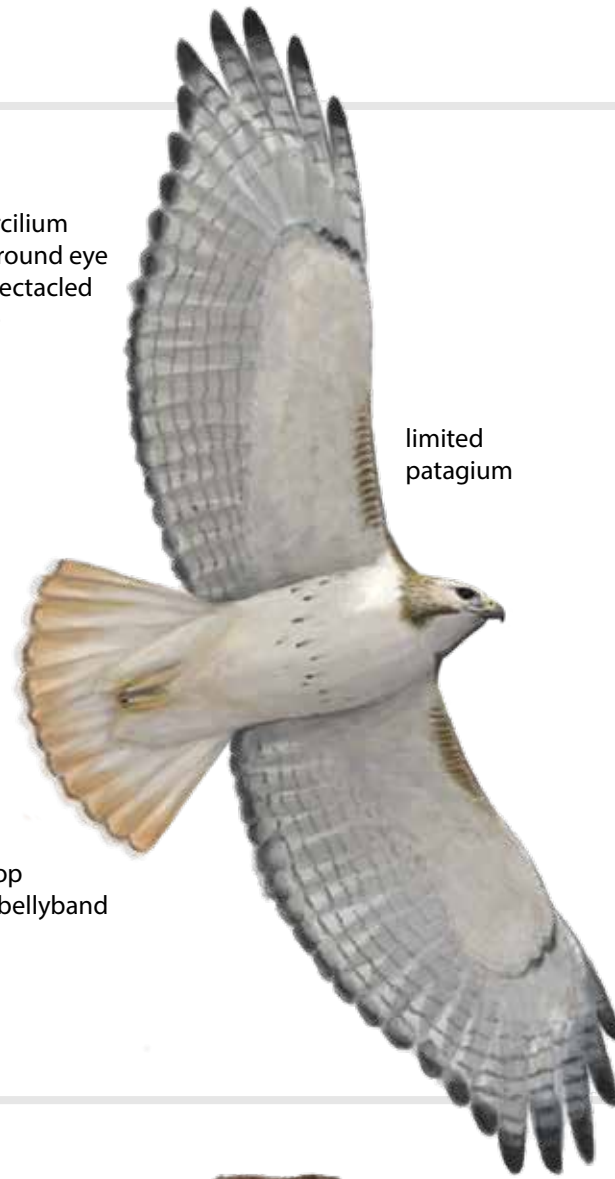
white supercilium wrapping around eye creates a spectacled appearance

prominent malar

body color ranges from snow white to cream



long, tear drop markings to bellyband



limited patagium

scapulars and median upperwing coverts very pale

rufous rump

rufous in upperwing and mantle

uppertail coverts average unmarked and white, blending with pale tail base

tail variation

variation may represent influence from neighboring subspecies

tail can be similar in color to *harlani*, but lacks irregularities in markings

most have thin subterminal band



rump ranges from dark brown to rufous

many have majority red tail



uppertail coverts white, usually unmarked but can show thin banding

tail bands common



JUVENILE

head variably pale, most with notable dark eyeline

black outline to pale eye creating a distinctive 'mascara' effect

Bold white primary panels with thin web-like bands

Crown clean white, nape variably marked darker

malar variably dark-streaked

lightly marked patagials and wing lining

uppertail coverts usually white

scapulars and upperwing coverts extensively white

many have a reddish tint to tail



typically unmarked greater underwing coverts



Tail whitish with thin bands that fade out toward base
